



Website Privacy Policy

Protecting your private information is our priority. This Statement of Privacy applies to the AgentApp24 Online Auto Insurance Purchasing Platform website, <https://www.agentapp24.com>, which is owned and operated by Conquest Financial Services Group Incorporated (hereinafter “Conquest”). TRUSTe Privacy Program

Collection of your Personal Information

Conquest may collect personally identifiable information, such as your name. If you purchase Conquest's products and services, we collect billing and credit card information. This information is used to complete the purchase transaction. Conquest may also collect anonymous demographic information, which is not unique to you, such as your age and gender. We may gather additional personal or non-personal information in the future.

Information about your computer hardware and software may be automatically collected by Conquest. This information can include: your IP address, browser type, domain names, access times and referring website addresses. This information is used for the operation of the service, to maintain quality of the service, and to provide general statistics regarding use of the Conquest website.

Please keep in mind that if you directly disclose personally identifiable information or personally sensitive data through Conquest's public message boards, this information may be collected and used by others.

Use of your Personal Information

Conquest collects and uses your personal information to operate its website(s) and deliver the services you have requested.

Conquest may also use your personally identifiable information to inform you of other products or services available from Conquest and its affiliates. Conquest may also contact you via surveys to conduct research about your opinion of current services or of potential new services that may be offered.

Conquest does not sell, rent or lease its customer lists to third parties.

Conquest may share data with trusted partners to help perform statistical analysis, send you email or postal mail, provide customer support, or arrange for deliveries. All such third parties are prohibited from using your personal information except to provide these services to Conquest, and they are required to maintain the confidentiality of your information.

Conquest may keep track of the websites and pages our users visit within Conquest, in order to determine what Conquest services are the most popular. This data is used to deliver customized content and advertising within Conquest to customers whose behavior indicates that they are interested in a particular subject area.

Conquest will disclose your personal information, without notice, only if required to do so by law or in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to: (a) conform to the edicts of the law or comply with legal process served on Conquest or the site; (b) protect and defend the rights or property of Conquest; and, (c) act under exigent circumstances to protect the personal safety of users of Conquest, or the public.

Use of Cookies

The Conquest website may use "cookies" to help you personalize your online experience. A cookie is a text file that is placed on your hard disk by a web page server. Cookies cannot be used to run programs or deliver viruses to your computer. Cookies are uniquely assigned to you, and can only be read by a web server in the domain that issued the cookie to you.

One of the primary purposes of cookies is to provide a convenience feature to save you time. The purpose of a cookie is to tell the Web server that you have returned to a specific page. For example, if you personalize Conquest pages, or register with Conquest site or services, a cookie helps Conquest to recall your specific information on subsequent visits.
